Since our last communication with you Te Korowai Aroha o Aotearoa has undergone an in depth review of the whole organisation from Governance to Operations. This has resulted in a new structure and systems which we are now in the process of finalising towards ISO 9001:2000 Accreditation.

Identified in the review was the need to ensure that Te Manatu Maori Tuku Tohu (Indigenous Qualifications Framework) was further developed and improved. To this end a new work stream has been introduced into the structure of Te Korowai Aroha o Aotearoa. This will be headed by a new position of Puna Matauranga.

At this time I wish to announce that I will be leaving the position of Pouarahi to take up this crucial role of Puna Matauranga. I look forward to the challenges and opportunities that this new role will bring and to working with the new Pouarahi once they are appointed.

Moerangi also works as CEO for Ngati Rangatahi Whanaunga Association which is currently working towards Treaty Settlement and capacity development.

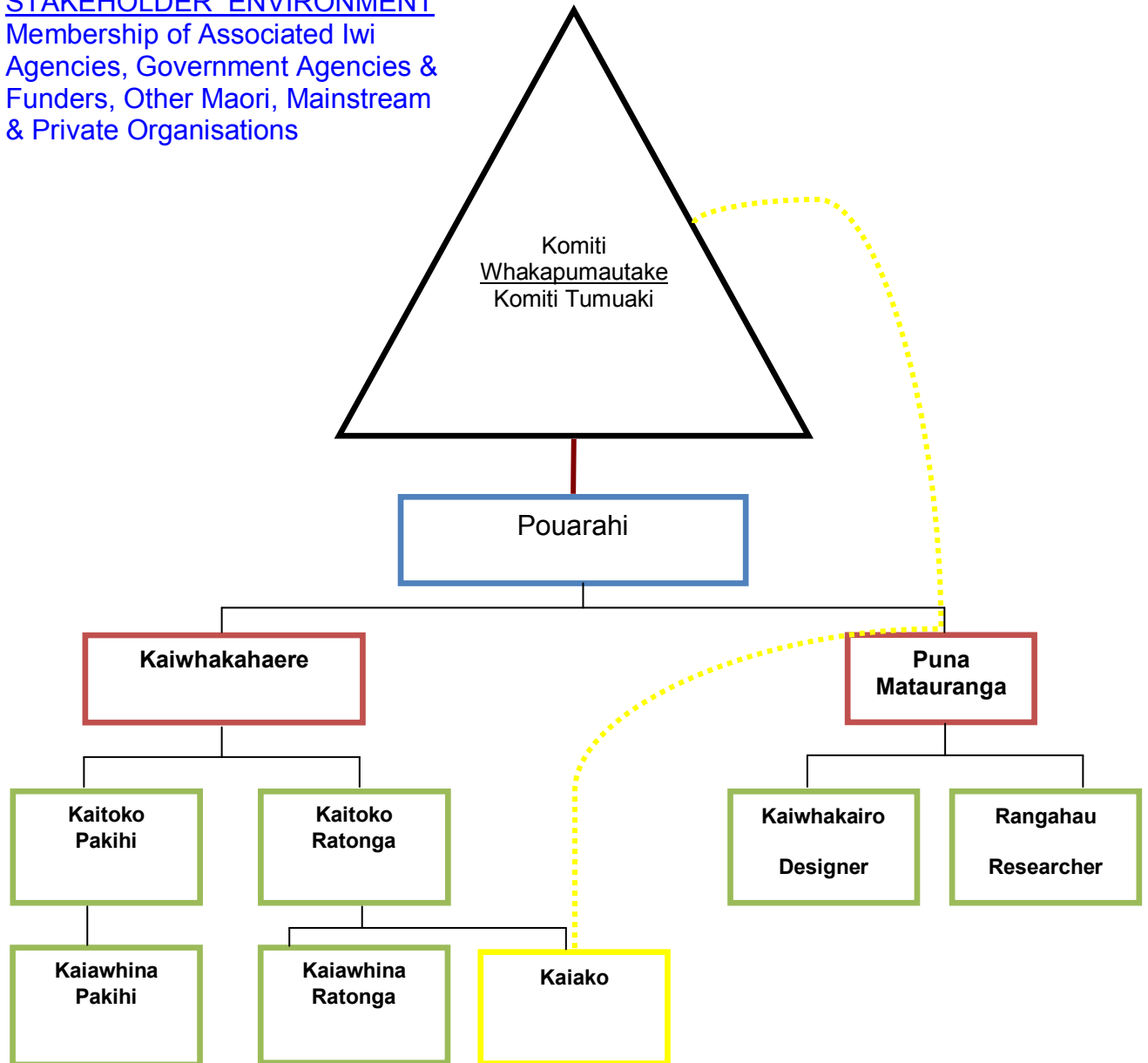

CONSTITUTIONAL REMIT DUE: 12 October 2009

Amendment to Clause 8.2 of the Constitution of Te Korowai Aroha o Aotearoa which currently reads:

“Komiti Tumuaki shall consist of 9 officers. Two officers will directly represent the Associated Iwi Agency membership group. All officers will be skilled in the following areas: education and training, professional practices, Te Reo Maori me ona Tikanga, policy and procedures, finance, legal, business, hapu development.”

The proposed amendment shall read:

Komiti Tumuaki shall consist of 9 officers.

- Two officers will directly represent the Associated Iwi Agency membership group. All officers will be skilled in the following areas: education and training, professional practices, Te Reo Maori me ona Tikanga, policy and procedures, finance, legal, business, hapu development.
- Two officers shall be members of the Komiti Whakapumautake.

Further remits for the Hui-ā-Tau 2009 (Annual General Conference) and amendments to the TKAA Constitution, including objections to the proposed remit above, must be sent to the Chairperson by **12 October 2009**. See contact details below. *Copies of the constitution are on the TKAA website.*

Earlier this year Awhina Daly also passed away due to illness.

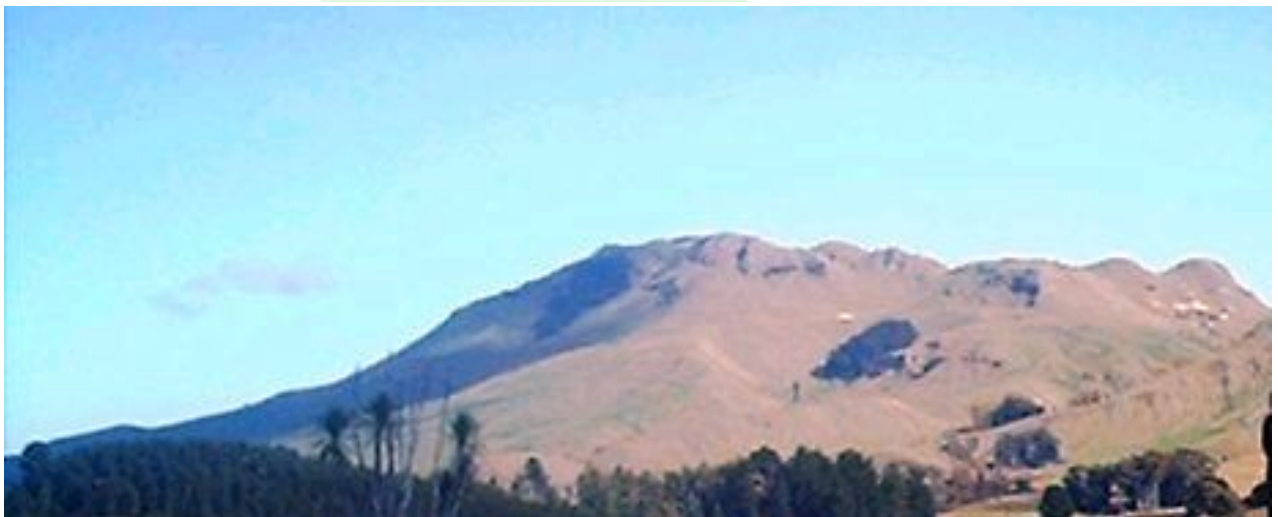
